



Task Risk Assessment



Task Risk Assessment (TRA)

Target Group

Limited to 12 attendees, this course is primarily aimed at personnel who are involved in planning tasks that are potentially hazardous and therefore attendees should be employed or potential to be employed at the Supervisor level.

Aim

This 4 hour programme aims to explain that risk assessment is a continual process beginning at the planning stages of a task, and continues throughout that task.

Training Objectives

By the end of the course, delegates will be able to:

- Demonstrate awareness of the relevant regulations pertaining to Risk Assessment and of the duties of the employer and employee regarding the Risk Assessment process.
- Identify different types and levels of Risk Assessment employed in the workplace.
- Gather information on potential hazards/barriers in the workplace and assess the potential risks.
- Identify hazards associated with a task
- Demonstrate a good understanding of the Risk Assessment process and auditing requirements.
- Conduct a Risk Assessment and complete the relevant documentation.
- Demonstrate awareness of different personnel's involvement in the Risk Assessment process.

Course Content Summary:

Delegates will receive training in

- Identification of hazards in the workplace;
- different types of risk assessments,
- · how to identify control measures,
- how to implement them effectively and
- the duties of employers and employees.

Achievement Measurement

This 4 hour course is a mix of theoretical and practical sessions, during which delegates will be required to demonstrate their level of knowledge and understanding of the training programme content. Certificate, valid for 2 years, will be issued after successful completion.
