



Confined Space Entry Awareness

Target Group

This OSHA compliant confined space course is designed for all personnel directly or indirectly involved in work associated with a confined space. Any person who is required to issue permits for confined space entry, supervise a confined space entry, enter a confined space for whatever reason, act as a standby person, or be involved in a confined space rescue team, must attend this 4 hour programme. Course are restricted to a maximum of 12 attendees.

Aim

The aim of the course is to provide selected delegates with basic underpinning knowledge and skills required to undertake safe operations for confined space related work

Training Objectives

By the end of the course, delegates will be able to:

- Identify hazards, including mode, symptoms, and consequences of exposure to hazards.
- Identify conditions that warrant evacuation of a permit space
- Identify behavioural effects of hazard exposure in entrants.
- Use equipment required for entry, including the proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Use procedures and means to alert the attendant and attendants to alert entrants to evacuate.
- Use procedures and means to summon evacuation and rescue services.
- Carry out evacuation and non-entry rescue procedures.
- Take action when unauthorized entrants approach or enter a permit space.
- Demonstrate knowledge of lockout/tagout procedures and equipment as necessary.
- Carry out entry permit and a verification process (what tests were performed, what procedures and equipment are in place, etc.).

Achievement Measurement

This 4 hour course is carried out in accordance the requirements of OSHA and includes practical (where possible) and written assessments leading to certification on successful completion. Certification is valid for 3 years.
